Airport SuperShuttle

AANP Conference attendees can receive discounted fares on SuperShuttle for airport transportation to and from the Gaylord National by calling 800-622-2089 and giving the AANP discount code PGTR4 or going online to www.supershuttle.com and entering this same group discount code. Discounts are available for travel in and out of DCA, BWI and IAD airports.

Overflow Hotel Shuttle Service

Due to the record breaking attendance at this year's AANP national conference, it is necessary for some of our attendees to stay at overflow hotels just outside of National Harbor on Oxon Hill Road, and in Old Town Alexandria as well as Crystal City near the Reagan Airport. AANP will be providing shuttle bus service between the Gaylord and official overflow properties on Oxon Hill Road and in the Old Town Alexandria area. Attendees staying in Crystal City will need to take the Metro from the Marriott Station to the King Street Station where they can catch the shuttle to Gaylord. All shuttles will pick-up and drop-off at the Gaylord National entrance between the Baltimore Meeting Rooms and Fort Washington Board Room. Signage at this entrance will inform attendees of the various shuttle routes to assist you in knowing the correct route to your particular hotel. On all routes shuttles will be available approximately every 30 minutes between 6:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. each morning and will again run at this frequency between 6:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. each evening. During midday conference hours of 10:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m., shuttle service will run an extended (less frequent) loop of these properties for those needing to leave the conference activities for their hotel.

Thursday's Legislative Day Visits to Capitol Hill

The same Gaylord entrance is also the site for the shuttle service provided for attendee visits to Capitol Hill on Thursday afternoon. The buses will shuttle from 12:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. on Thursday with drop-off and pick-up at the official Capitol Shuttle stops.

For those attendees who wish to stay in the Capitol Hill area on Thursday evening for dinner and shopping, AANP has arranged for shuttle pick-up service to continue from Union Station from 6:00 p.m. – 10:00 p.m. on Thursday evening. There are many restaurants and shops in this historic train station. On Thursday evening, shuttles to the overflow hotels will continue from the Gaylord until 11:00 p.m. to facilitate getting everyone back to their hotels after return from the Capitol Hill area.

Sight-Seeing

For attendees and their families wishing to shop and dine in the surrounding area during the evenings, there are several options for travel other than taxi. There are two water taxis from National Harbor, one departs from the Gaylord pier and one from the National Harbor pier. These provide a unique way to taxi to Old Town Alexandria and offer water tours of other DC area attractions. Check with the Gaylord concierge's desk for full details.

AANP has enhanced the King Street shuttle service between 6:00 p.m. – 10:00 p.m. on Friday, Sunday and Monday evenings for attendees wishing to spend an evening of shopping and dining in Old Town Alexandria or catch the Metro at King Street Station and travel to other sites in the DC area.
